➤ **RP Global Missions Prayer Request** – Please pray for our church in South Asia. They have just entered the dry summer season - in the apartment building where one family lives, running water is available only 8 hours in the day at scheduled times. Some in their congregation have gone two days without any water! In the surrounding districts, agriculture has been hit hard by the drought conditions. Pray for early and heavy monsoon rains. "Ask rain from the LORD at the time of the spring rain, the LORD who makes the storm clouds; and he will give them showers of rain" (Zechariah 10:1). "In a dry and thirsty land where there is no water," may all in their land thirst for the LORD God (Psalm 63:1). May the Word of God preached in churches in their city draw many to the One who "sends rain on the just and the unjust" (Matthew 5:45). Praise God for the number of visitors that they have been having recently! May the Lord use the church in their lives and lead some to join their church family.
