➤ Each week, there is also an opportunity to enjoy fellowship together over lunch following our Prayer Meeting or Sermon Discussion. Everyone is welcome to join in this – If you are able, please bring food to share if you plan to stay *(if everyone who is able brings a little more than you would normally make for Sunday lunch, there will be plenty to share)*.

➤ **Evening Fellowship** will be tonight at 6 pm at the church building or by Zoom – we will be looking at the **Westminster Confession of Faith, Ch. 33: Of the Last Judgement**.

Ask the Lord to use the training of parents, elders, and deacons in all the covenant children's lives. Petition God to effectually call these children to Jesus Christ through faith.
